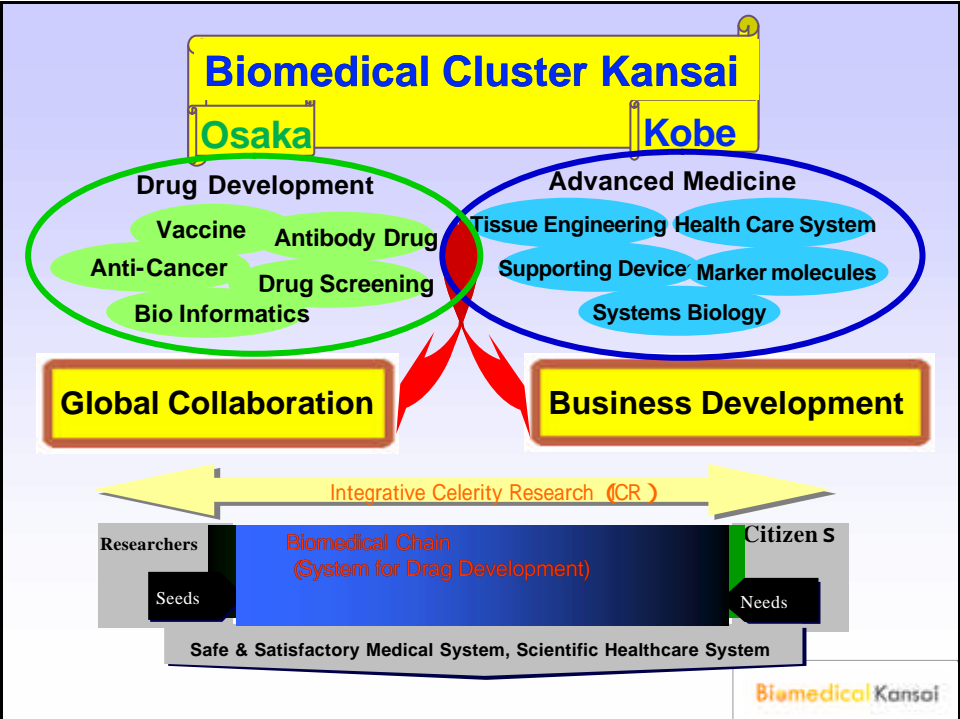
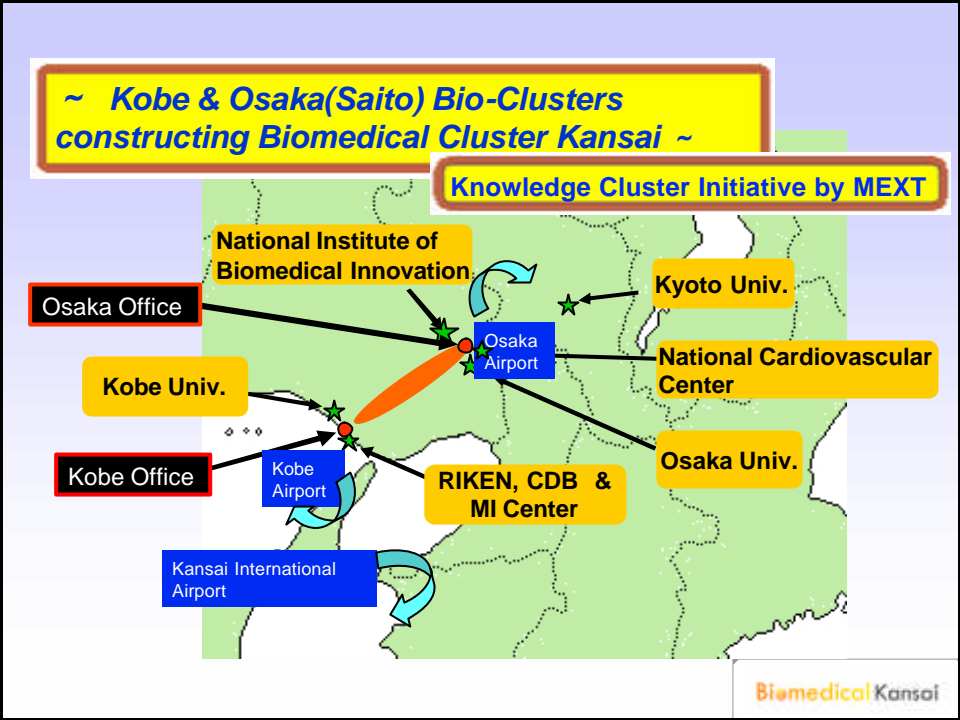

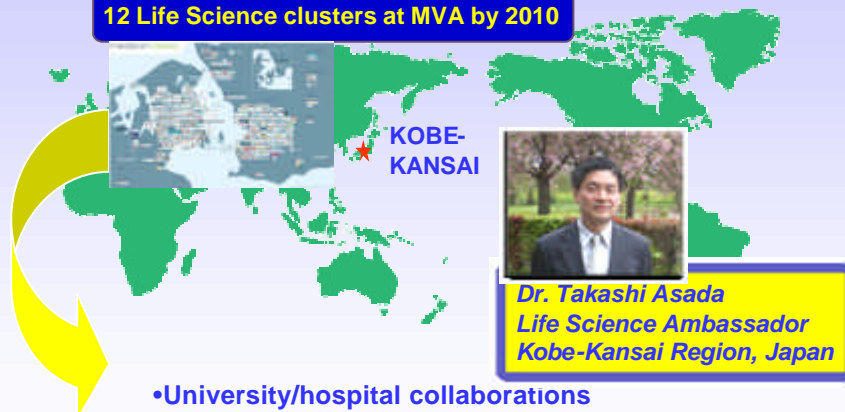

12 Life Science clusters at MVA by 2010



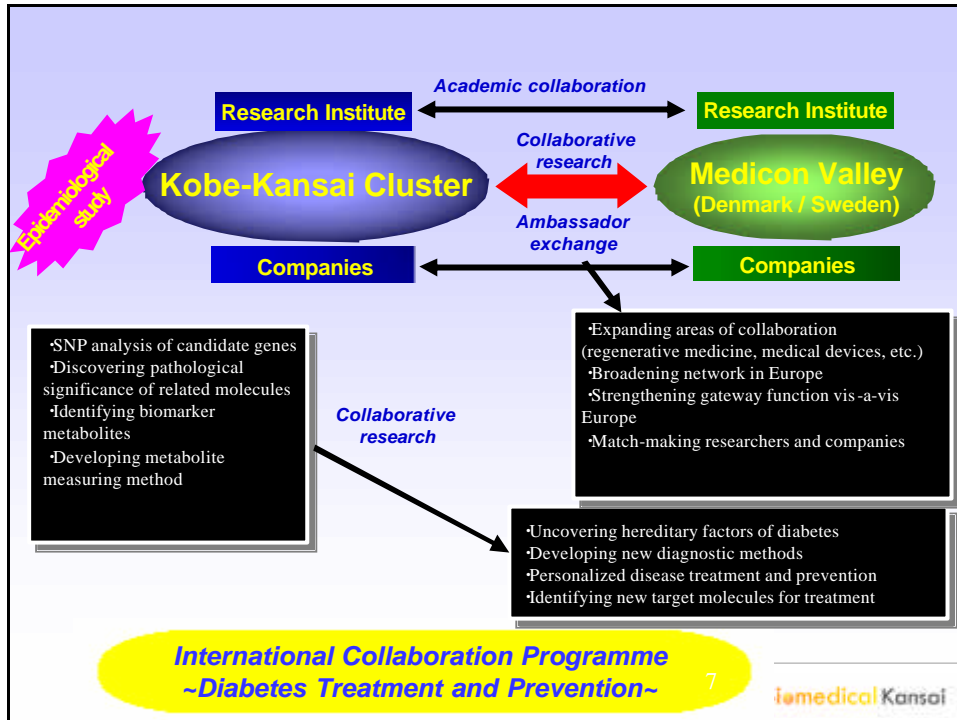

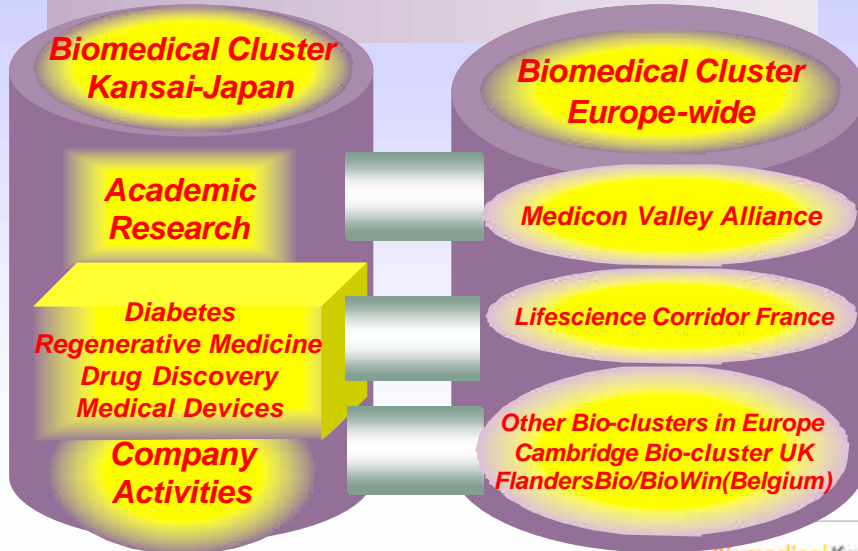

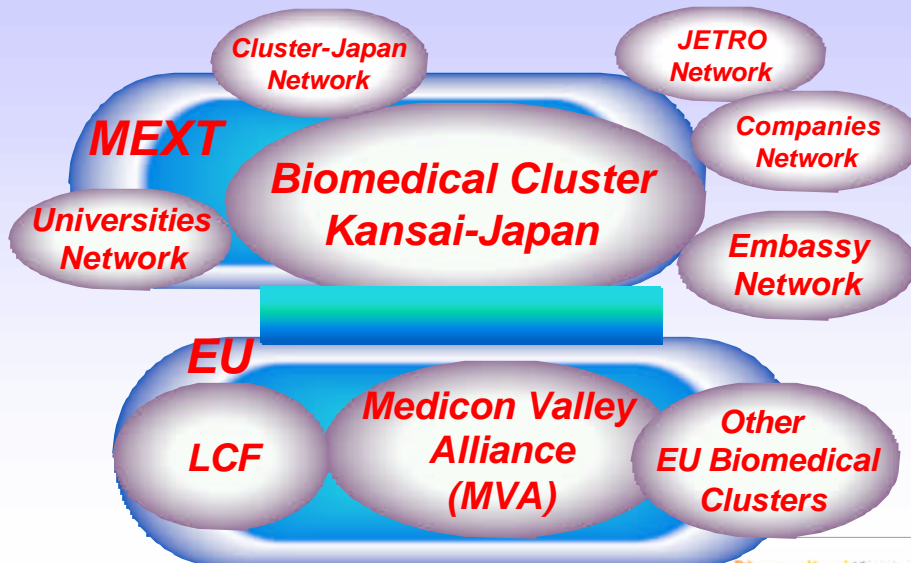
